

*Theobald Meisberger to Sarah Ann Strauser, Deed
Northumberland County, Pennsylvania
Deed Book 81, pages 320, 321 & 322
Drawn 6 Oct 1881; recorded 21 Oct 1881*

6 October 1881, Theobald Meisberger and Mary Catharine, his wife, of Coal Township, Northumberland, Pennsylvania convey to Sarah Ann Strauser of the same place, for the sum of \$550.00 the lot in Coal Township, described as:

"Beginning at a post one hundred feet south of the north east corner of the John Brady tract, thence south eighteen and one half degrees East one hundred and forty feet to a post thence West Seventy one feet thence Northward about one hundred and forty five feet to a post thence eastward sixty two and a half feet to the place of beginning[.]"

The lot was part of a larger piece of ground that John B. Douty and Lavinia, his wife, on 13 September 1873, recorded in Deed Book No 66, pages 370 and 371, granted to Theobald Meisberger. "[Signed] Theobald Meisberger; Mary C. Meisberger, " in the presence of W^m. K. Erdman; Heinerich Siemann.

Received 6 October 1881 the sum of \$550.00. Witnesses: W^m. K. Erdman; Theobald Meisberger.

On 6 October 1881, Theobald and Mary Catharine Meisberger acknowledged the deed.
